FALL RIVER CONSERVATION DISTRICT FABRIC INSTALLATION AGREEMENT

It is mutually agreed that the following terms apply to Fall River County Conservation District's weed barrier fabric installation.

The Fall River County Conservation District will provide fabric, labor, equipment and staples.

The producer will keep the ground properly prepared until fabric is installed. This includes knocking down the ridge created by the tree planter and working the ground, if needed, to control any new weeds between tree planting and fabric installation. Weed barrier may be installed on a separate day that trees are planted.

The producer is responsible for maintaining the fabric after the installation. The fabric should be checked after strong winds and rains. Every year the tree holes should be checked and made larger if needed to accommodate the growing trees.

Prices are as follows: \$50 equipment fee for plantings totaling less than \$1,000; \$1.00 per linear foot for fabric and installation. Taxes where applicable. Mileage charge of \$1.20 per mile round trip from tree cooler to site.

Fall River Conservation District requires a 50% deposit on fabric before January 1, 2023.
